What does the Coach do?

Who does the Coach report to?

What qualifications do I need to have?

- FA Level 1 in Coaching. If you do not have this, then full training will be provided as per the details below.

What training will I need to do?

- FA Level 1 in Coaching Course
- FA Emergency Aid Course
- FA Safeguarding Children Course
- All course costs are covered by Larkspur Rovers Football Club

How much time is involved?

- You will train for 1 hour per week, for approximately 48 weeks within the season
- Additional time will be required for the other activities outlined in the Coaches Charter
