What does the AWO do?

- Support the Club Welfare Officer (CWO)
- Support Club volunteers in gaining and maintaining their Safeguarding qualifications
- Support players and parents with any welfare issues on matchdays and at training sessions

Who does the AWO work with?

- You will work with the CWO and the Club volunteer staff, to ensure the high standards of Welfare and Safeguarding are met within the Club.

Who does the AWO report to?

- You will report to the CWO

What qualifications do I need to have?

- None, as full training will be provided (see below) if you are not already qualified from a previous role.
- Preferred knowledge of Safeguarding principles

What training will I need to do?

- FA Safeguarding Adults Course
- FA Safeguarding Children Course
- All course costs are covered by Larkspur Rovers Football Club

How much time is involved?

- Approximately 2 hours per week, dependent on the number of available Welfare Officers to cover Welfare duties in that week
