Assistant Coach (Under 10)

What does the Assistant Coach do?

- Supports the Coach (Under 10) in providing a 1 hour training session per week for an Under 10 squad.
- Supports the Coach (Under 10) in being responsible for creating a safe, positive and enjoyable training environment
- Supports the Coach (Under 10) in being a Point of Contact for parents of Under 10 age group

Who does the Assistant Coach report to?

You will report to the Head of Youth Phase

What qualifications do I need to have?

• FA Level 1 in Coaching. If you do not have this, then full training will be provided as per the details below.

What training will I need to do?

- FA Level 1 in Coaching Course
- FA Emergency Aid Course
- FA Safeguarding Children Course
- All course costs are covered by Larkspur Rovers Football Club

How much time is involved?

- You will train for 1 hour per week, for approximately 48 weeks within the season
- Additional time will be required for the other activities outlined in the Coaches Charter
